Resource Consents

What is a resource consent?

A consent is an approval to undertake certain activities identified in rules. They are generally required for activities that have more of an impact on the environment.

Resource consents specify:

- 1. The length of time an activity can be carried out, and
- 2. Any specific conditions that need to be met.

What is the proposed consenting system?

Three types of consent classes are being proposed:

Permitted activity

No consent needed as long as rule conditions are met

Controlled activity

Consent needed and will be granted as long as rule conditions are met

Non-complying

Consent needed and may be declined

Whether a landowner will need a resource consent depends on:

- Property size
- Rate of nitrogen loss from activities on the property
- If managed nitrogen reductions are planned for
