  - 10 landowners in the Lake Rotorua catchment
    - Dairy (3); Drystock (5); Mixed (1); Forestry (1)
    - Included
      - Iwi (3); Smallholdings (1)
  - 4 BOPRC staff who work with landowners in the Lake Rotorua catchment



## Key messages

- Personalised negotiations / independent advisors
- Clear and simple information
- Package that allows incremental reductions
- Working with other incentives, e.g. biodiversity funding
- Creative options
- Positive cost-benefit



#### Barriers

- Lack of detail on how the incentives scheme will work
- Risk aversion permanent land use change
- Possibility of regulatory change
- Legal enforceability of the rules
- Overseer modelling alternative land uses
- Ongoing economic viability of farms
