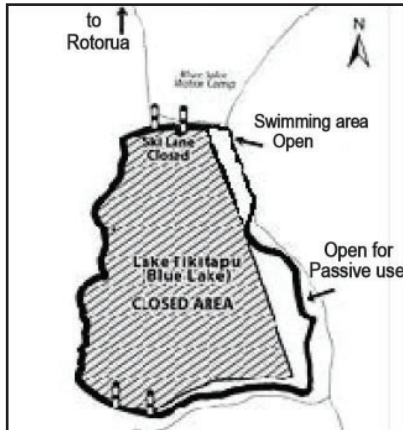


**Notice of Full Lake Closure
Lake Tikitapu (Blue Lake)
(South East and North Eastern areas
remain open for Passive Use)**

The public is hereby advised that pursuant to Bay of Plenty Regional Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017, Lake Tikitapu will be **closed** from 4pm Friday 17 January until 6pm Sunday 19 January 2020 to permit Rotorua Rowing Club to host a Rowing Regatta.

The boat ramp will be inaccessible during the closure.

The Waterski, Southern, South Eastern and North Eastern Passive Recreation Areas of the lake will be open and available for passive use / non-powered vessels throughout the duration of the lake closure period.
