of the North Western Passive Recreation Area of the lake only. The remainder of the lake will be open and available for all other lake users.

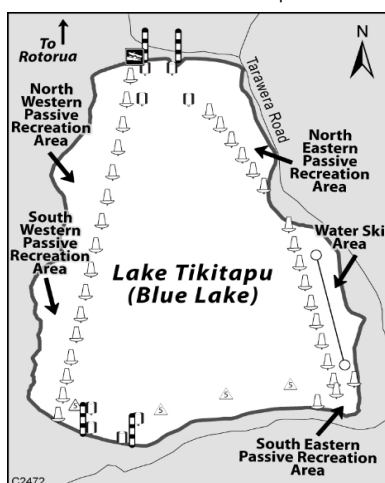
Open Water Swim 1500 - 1900 hrs. FULL LAKE CLOSURE

The North Eastern and South Western Passive Recreation Areas of the lake will remain available for passive use only.

Sprint Triathlon 0700 - 1030 hrs FULL LAKE CLOSURE

The Water Ski and all Southern Passive Recreation Areas of the lake will remain available for passive use only.
