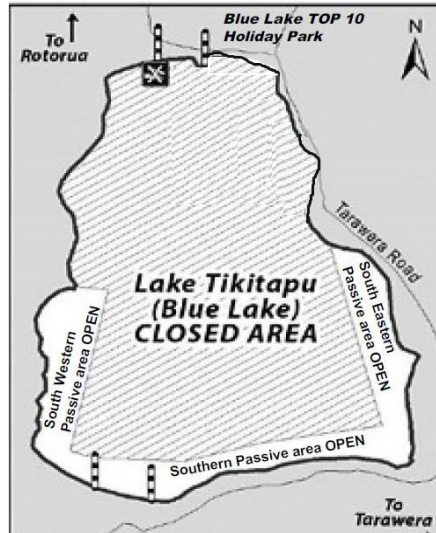


Notice of Full Lake Closure (Southern passive areas open) Lake Tikitapu (Blue Lake)

The public is hereby advised that pursuant to Bay of Plenty Regional Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017, Clause 3.9.4, **Lake Tikitapu will be closed** as detailed below to permit Te Waiariki Pūrea Trust to host the National Secondary Schools Waka Ama Championships.

Event starts Tuesday 23 March 2021 at 8am
Event ends Friday 26 March 2021 at 7pm
Saturday 20 - Sunday 21 March Set up starts at 7am

The **boat ramp will be inaccessible** during this period however the Passive areas shown below will remain open and available during the closure period for passive use only.
