
Notice of Full Lake Closure Lake Tikitapu (Blue Lake) (North East and South Eastern areas remain open for passive use)

The public is hereby advised that pursuant to Bay of Plenty Regional Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017, 3.9.4, Lake Tikitapu will be **closed** from **4pm Friday 21 January until 5pm Sunday 23 January 2022** to permit Rotorua Rowing Club to host a Rowing Regatta.

The Waterski, Southern, South Eastern and North Eastern Passive Recreation Areas of the lake will be open and available for passive use / non-powered vessels throughout the duration of the lake closure period.
