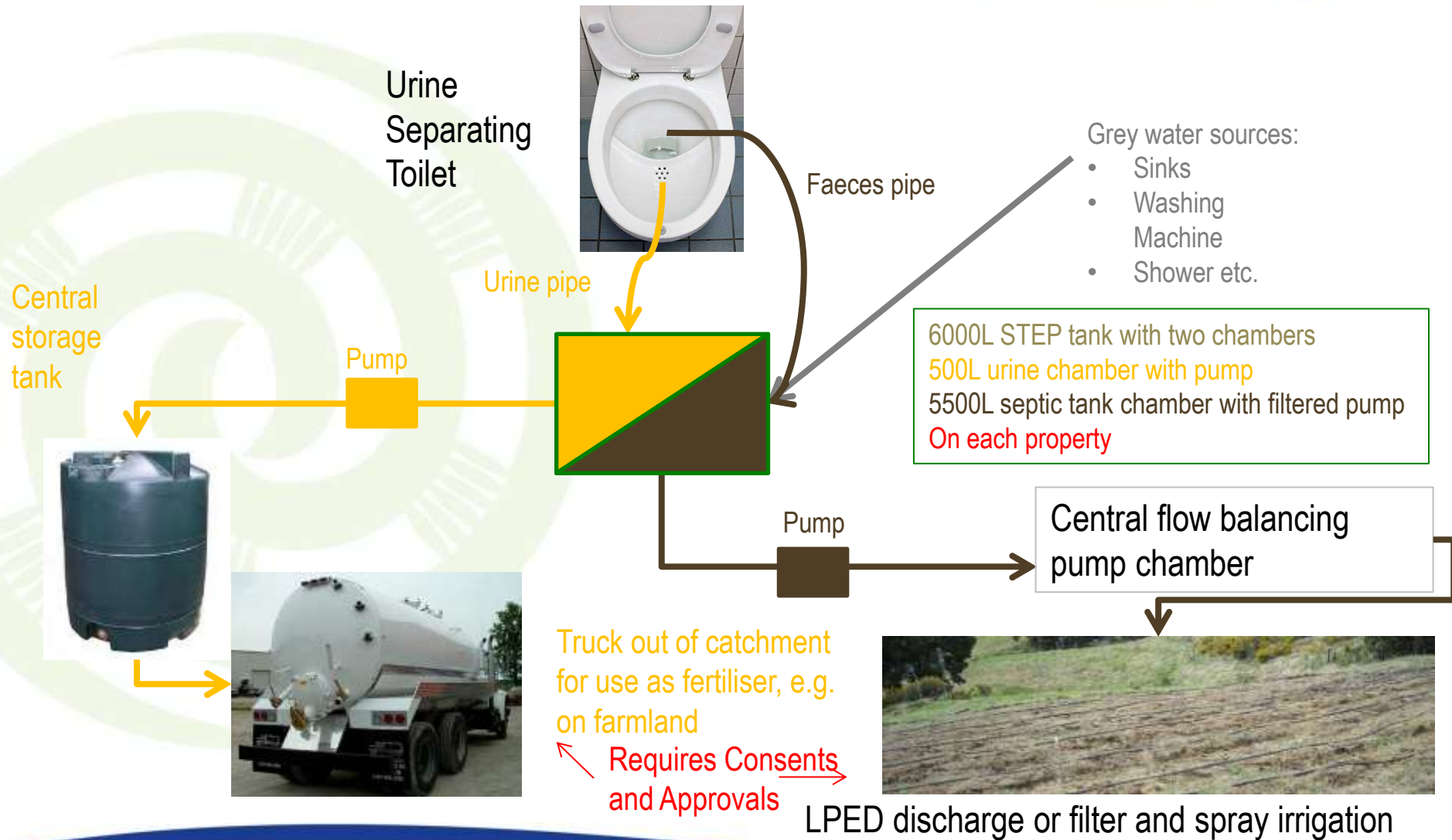
DRASTIC = Decentralised Reduction at Source to Implement Change

Separation of urine and faecal matter at the WC

# Cost to individuals of OSET

Cost varies for each household:

- Compliant drainage required for all OSET options
- Cost depends on property and existing system
- Consent requires compliant septic tank (OSET 2 & 3)
- Many old septic tanks will need replacement

# DRASTIC - new to NZ

## Preliminary MoH subsidy position

- eligible for subsidy for interceptor tank and downstream, but not for works inside houses
- if the system stacks up on its own merits, eg cost, sustainability, reliability, proven performance, user acceptability etc, it would be eligible for subsidy
- current overseas experience relevant
